The [ERIGrid](#) project has been successfully finished this year in April. On behalf of the [ERIGrid consortium](#) I want to take the opportunity to thank you very much for your kind support as member of the User Selection Panel (USP) and for all your valuable reviews of TA user project proposals which you have carried out. With your support we have been able to support 73 (out of 97) TA user projects with about 175 persons and around 1,000 lab days (see also [realized TA projects](#) and [success stories](#)).
